At Camp Immokalee, we're honored to provide a space for faith communities to gather, reflect, and grow together. Nestled along the shores of Lake Brooklyn, our peaceful, natural setting offers the perfect environment for worship, fellowship, and fun. Whether you're looking to host a weekend of group worship, small-group studies, or simply quiet reflection, our camp provides a welcoming backdrop for faith-based retreats of all kinds.

# What to Expect Lodging

Our bunk-style cabins create a simple, comfortable environment for unplugging and reconnecting. Lodging options include:

- West Side Cabins: 8 cabins with bathrooms inside, hosting up to 14 guests in bunk beds. Groups can halve capacity to avoid top bunks.
- East Side Cabins: 6 cabins with access to a central bathhouse, accommodating 16–20 guests each.
- Adventure Village: One ADA-accessible cabin with a private toilet and sink, plus two yurts sharing a central bathhouse.

We also offer a private apartment with a queen bedroom and small living room—perfect for retreat leaders or pastors looking for extra comfort and quiet.





## **Dining**

Meals are served in our dining hall, which accommodates up to 150 guests. Choose from several dining options to best suit your group's needs:

- Family-Style: Traditional sit-down meals that foster a sense of community.
- Buffet: A flexible option to cater to varied tastes.
- Grab-and-Go: Great for groups with busy schedules.

Special diets are welcome, and we're happy to help plan meal options that align with your group's preferences.

# **Pricing**

- Additional quests: \$90 per person
